IMPORTANT REMINDERS

The Town of Bruderheim's **Community Standards Bylaw** has restrictions regarding vehicles, trailers and recreational vehicles. The Community Standards Bylaw holds restrictions related to the storage of recreational vehicles, dilapidated or inoperable vehicles, as well as garbage or loose materials.

- No person shall park a motor vehicle or recreational vehicle on private property within one metre of a sidewalk
 - No person shall park a motor vehicle or recreational vehicle in the front portion of the living space of a residential property.
 - Restrictions also apply to dilapidated, inoperable and unregistered vehicles
- Failure to comply with this section shall result in the motor vehicle or recreational vehicle being towed at the Registered Owners expense. Please ensure you are aware of regulations. The Community Standards Bylaw 45-2016 is available by contacting the Town Office or by visiting the Town of Bruderheim website.

You must obtain a **fire pit permit** from the Town Office for all backyard fire pits. This is a one-time permit (does not have to be renewed annually) and the cost is \$10. Every fire pit must have a grate on it, be 3 metres from any building, property line or combustible material, and be less than 0.6 metres high and 1 metre in diameter. It cannot be constructed over gas lines or electrical lines. ONLY untreated wood, propane, natural gas or charcoal may be used in the fire pit, no garbage, garden refuse, etc. The fire pit must be under control at ALL TIMES.
