**PLEASE PREPARE YOUR YARDS FOR WINTER**—With fall here, the Town of Bruderheim would like to remind residents to prepare their yards for winter. Grass clippings, garden waste and leaves cleaned from yards and gutters will help overland drainage (from snow and rain runoff) in the spring. Cleaning boulevards and gutters around your property ensures that the catch basins don’t freeze up and cause flooding on private property.

**NO** straws or plastic utensils

**NO** plastic bags

**NO** hazardous waste

**YES** mixed paper and paperboard

**YES** tin cans

**YES** rigid plastic containers #1 & #2

**YES** deposit items such as tetra paks, pop and beer cans and bottles, milk containers
