## BRUDERHEIM ALERT SYSTEM

The Bruderheim Alert System is used to issue alerts in the event of an emergency or another event that may impact you. Everyone that signs up is entered into a draw for a home emergency preparedness kit.

**You pick where, you pick how**—You will receive time-sensitive messages in the manner(s) you specify: home phone, mobile, business phone, email and/or text messages.

**Choose your alerts**—The Bruderheim Alert System will issue messages about emergency alerts. This is any event which is considered an immediate threat to the safety and well-being of some/all Bruderheim residents. These notifications include, but are not limited to:

- Severe weather watches/warnings (when Environment Canada issues weather alerts)
- Public safety notifications, including water, fire, RCMP
- Local events such as road or bridge closures, snow clearing, road bans, County events, etc.

\*\*\* You choose the types of messaging you wish to receive.
