BYLAW 15-2018

BYLAW No. 15-2018, OF THE TOWN OF BRUDERHEIM, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, BEING A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH THE TOWN OF BRUDERHEIM'S AND LAMONT COUNTY'S INTER-MUNICIPAL SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD.

WHEREAS, Section 627 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, as amended, authorizes a municipality to enter into an agreement with one or more municipalities to establish an Inter-Municipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Board;

AND WHEREAS, said agreement must provide for the procedure and conduct of the Inter-Municipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Board, and the functions and duties of its members;

AND WHEREAS, the Town Council of Bruderheim have requested of Lamont County to establish an Inter-Municipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Board;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Bruderheim deems it appropriate to establish an Inter-Municipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Board to hear subdivision and/or development appeals between the Town of Bruderheim and Lamont County;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Bruderheim duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:


1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Town of Bruderheim Inter-Municipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Bylaw".
2. An Inter-Municipal Subdivisions and Development Appeal Board is hereby established.
3. The Council of the Town of Bruderheim is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Councils of the Town of Bruderheim and Lamont County to provide for the following:
 - I) The hearing of subdivision appeals and development appeals within the municipal boundaries of the Town of Bruderheim and Lamont County.
 - II) The procedure and conduct of the Inter-Municipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Boards and its members; and
 - III) The functions and duties of the Inter-Municipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Board.
4. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon the Third and Final Reading of this bylaw.

Bylaw 763-2007 is hereby repealed.
