Combined assessment and tax notices will be sent to all property owners by May 31st, 2024. If you have not received your notice by June 2nd please contact the Town Office. Property taxes are due June 30th. For more information on property taxes and assessment, please go to FAQs (bruderheim.ca), contact the Town Office at 780-796-3731 or email info@bruderheim.ca. Tax penalties were passed by Council, which include a 9% penalty on current outstanding taxes July 1st, 6% on August 1st and 3% on September 1st. On outstanding amounts there will be 9% penalty January 1st, 6% February 1st, and 3% March 1st. To lighten the load you may be interested in tax installment payments-for more information, visit Tax Installment Payment Plan (bruderheim.ca). This plan gives you a full 12 months to pay your taxes in monthly installments.
