Notice of application to be filed for approval of the natural gas distribution franchise agreement between the Town of Bruderheim and ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd.

Application summary: ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. will submit an application to the Alberta Utilities Commission for approval of the current franchise agreement with the Town of Bruderheim, due to recent legislative changes. The agreement, effective since March 2016, grants ATCO exclusive rights to deliver natural gas in Bruderheim for 10 years. No changes to the agreement or the 20% franchise fee are proposed. The average residential customer's monthly fee, including taxes, remains around \$11.71. The franchise fee is calculated based on distribution charges.
